Intercedes For Us"

NOTES:

When we come to Jesus, our High Priest, we begin to receive His salvation and His intercession. Before we are ever called to give out to others, we are called to receive from Jesus. The benefits of salvation are applied to us through Jesus's intercession for us.

One of the most comforting things that we can know today is that Jesus is praying for us—right now! If you don't learn how to receive from the Lord praying for you, you will struggle to pray for others.

When Jesus intercedes, He intervenes on our behalf. He is the creator of all, so as He speaks, things happen. The enemy wants you to think that everything is out of control around you; but in reality, Jesus is fully in control and bringing the Kingdom of Heaven through His intercession.
